

Autism NI's Superhero Week, 19th 23rd April 2021

involves UCM Mini Music and Musical Games classes again this year, as part of Autism Awareness Month.

Each child is given **five Superhero Tasks** to do at home and a sponsor form to help them fundraise (OPTIONAL, all children take part anyway). Once all tasks are complete, the UCM will hold a **Superhero (Musical) Dress-Up Day** (24 April) by asking pupils to dress up as their favourite superhero or make their own masks... it's up to you – you could be anything from a Marvel character to a Disney princess or fireman. *Autism NI* state that currently one in twenty-four school age children are diagnosed with autism in Northern Ireland which is essentially one pupil in every classroom. Raising awareness will help create a society that works best for autistic children across Northern Ireland.


Get your school's superheroes to assemble for Autism NI's **SUPERHERO WEEK** and help raise autism awareness in your school and at home!

On day five, each pupil will come to school dressed as their favourite Superhero or a costume they have made themselves and during assembly/class they will receive their Superhero Status with a certificate and sticker badge provided by Autism NI
